RESOLUTION TO TRANSFER DORMANT FUNDS FROM
THE BUILD INDIANA FUND #404 TO THE
GENERAL FUND OF THE TOWN OF BROWNSBURG

I.C. 36-1-8-5 gives the city and town councils authority to order the transfer of any unused and unencumbered balance in any fund raised by a general or special tax levy, the purposes of which have been fulfilled, to the general fund or rainy day fund. This action may be taken by a city or town council at any public meeting.

I.C. 36-1-8-5 states in part that “the fiscal body of the political subdivision shall order the balance of that fund to be transferred as follows, unless a statute provides that it be transferred otherwise....to the general fund or rainy day fund of the municipality.....”

IT IS THERFORE RESOLVED, that the Town Council for the Town of Brownsburg, Hendricks County, Indiana instruct the Clerk-Treasurer to make a transfer of funds from the Build Indiana Fund in the amount of Eleven Hundred Eighty-Four and 94/100 Dollars (\$1,184.94) to the General Fund.
