**AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BROWNSBURG,
INDIANA, AMENDING TITLE VII, CHAPTER 71, SECTION 71.57(A)(3) OF THE
BROWNSBURG TOWN CODE**

WHEREAS, the Town of Brownsburg, Indiana through the Town Council desires to amend and update the Ordinance relating to Maximum Lawful Speeds in School Zones.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BROWNSBURG, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section I. Title VII, Chapter 71, Section 71.57(A)(3) is hereby amend to read as follows:

§71.57 MAXIMUM LAWFUL SPEEDS; ALTERATION. Except when a special hazard exists that requires lower speed for compliance with §71.56, the limits specified in this section are the maximum lawful speeds. A person may not drive a vehicle on a highway at a speed in excess of the following maximum limits:

(A)(3) Twenty (20) miles per hour in a school zone during the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on school days.

Section II. All prior Ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with any provision of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section III. This Ordinance is hereby passed by the Town Council for the Town of Brownsburg, Indiana this _____ day of October, 2011.
