

Street Department Quarterly Report

March 14, 2012

The Street Department has many responsibilities:

- Snow Plowing and De-Icing of streets and Town owned parking lots
- Curb side limb, leaves, and Christmas tree pick up
- Maintaining and mowing right of way on Northfield Drive and all open spaces owned by the Town
- Installing and maintaining seasonal banners
- Resurfacing Town owned streets and patching as necessary
- Pouring new sidewalks and maintaining current
- Mosquito control
- Repairing and replacing storm and sanitary sewers
- Maintaining and replacing all street signage

This is not an all inclusive list; the Street Departments Goal is to help keep the Town of Brownsburg as clean and safe as possible.

Continuing Education

Two employees receive a Pesticide Applicators Certification for treating Mosquito Larva and Adult Mosquito. Ten Street Department employees maintain a CDL Drivers License; employees attend several safety meetings per year and are trained on several big and small pieces of equipment.

Current and Future Projects

Our office oversees all Capital Projects within the Town such as:

- Grant and Murphy Meadows under construction currently to be completed this fall
- Southside Drainage under design will go out for bid mid-summer 2012
- 136 and Odell project under design anticipate mid June construction
- Safe Routes to School under design

- New Water Plant construction will start second week of April to be completed February of 2013
- Northfield Drive West under design will be a 2013 project
- Northfield Drive East under design will be a 2013 project
- Traffic Signal Preemption
- Park Maintenance building
- Twin Street Odor Control under construction
