BLUEGRASS FESTIVAL

The Park Board approved the use of the Mobile Performance Stage for a Bluegrass Festival at Cornerstone Christian Church on July 28th. All proceeds would go to assist the tornado victims in Southern Indiana. The event would be free. The Park Board approved the use of the stage for this event and agreed to waive the rental fee of the stage established for Non-profits. The Park Board also agreed that the church would need to provide a \$500 refundable damage deposit and proper insurance documentation for the use of the stage.

Brownsburg Parks New Brand
