

## Street Department Quarterly Report

July 26, 2012

### The Street Department has many responsibilities:

- Snow Plowing and De-Icing of streets and town owned parking lots
- Curb side limb pick up and leaves
- Maintaining and mowing right of way on Northfield Drive and open spaces owned by the Town
- Installing and maintaining seasonal banners
- Resurfacing town owned streets
- Patching streets and pouring new sidewalks
- Mosquito control
- Repairing and replacing storm and sanitary sewers
- Maintaining and replacing all street sign

This is not an all inclusive list; the Street Departments Goal is to help keep the Town of Brownsburg as clean and safe as possible.

### Continuing Education

Two employees are certified to handle the chemicals for treating Mosquito Larva and Adult Mosquito. Ten employees maintain a CDL Drivers License; employees attend several safety meetings per year and are trained on several big and small pieces of equipment.

### Current and Future Projects

Grant and Murphy Meadows: project is in the last phase of construction project going very well

Southside Drainage: project is in Right of Way acquisition

136 and Odell: project Notice to proceed was issued June 25<sup>th</sup> construction will begin when Duke Energy relocates 2 Poles

Safe Routes to School: currently completing stage 3 plans as well as the environmental document

New Water Plant: new water main installed all lower concrete walls and floors are complete first level concrete pads are poured. Masonry work will start July 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Northfield Drive West: is in Right of Way acquisition

Northfield Dr East: is in Right of Way acquisition

Traffic Signal Preemption: working toward stage 3 plans

Twin Street Oder Control: project is complete

The Street Department has taken advantage of the dry summer correcting several storm water issues as well replacing numerous sidewalks thru out town.

Streets needing to be repaved are being identified for 2012 resurfacing program.
