Subject: Resolution Declaring Certain Property as Surplus Property NFD Lighting

Summary of Request:

Since 2010, staff has been planning for the replacement of the 56 overhead decorative street lights located on Northfield Drive from SR 267 to 56th Street. These lights were purchased and installed in 2003 and cost \$117,600 at that time. In staff's opinion, the chosen light fixtures were not designed for over the street lighting but is more consistent with campus lighting around corporate buildings. The lighting is not high enough and doesn't provide illumination to the street and also many of the fixtures are very near to the road causing concerns for collision with trucks and semis. In late June 2012, bids were opened for the replacement of these lights and the installation of proper underground conduit at a cost of \$624,620. This project was approved by the Redevelopment Commission and construction started as of two weeks ago. Staff is working with the Fire Territory for the use of less than 10 of these lights for their parking lots (which is consistent with their design) and the remaining lights will be bid via a sealed bid process. We would hope to get around \$500 to \$700 apiece for the lights which would potentially net \$23,000 to \$32,200.
